Saving Lives in the Wake of Hurricane Harvey

- 500 teammates volunteered in Texas to support patient care and their fellow teammates.
- DaVita kept more than 100 centers open and operational in the Houston-area after the storm.
- 1,000s of dialysis patients were cared for at DaVita clinics in the aftermath of Hurricane Harvey.
- One teammate - a dialysis patient herself - treated patients for 19 hours straight and came back the following morning to make sure the clinic was open.

Patient Care Continues After Hurricane Irma

- Nearly 900 Teammates from around the Village volunteered in the aftermath of the hurricane.
- Approx. 1,200 dialysis patients - including 350 non-DaVita patients - were cared for at DaVita clinics.
- Within 60 hours after the storm, 95% of DaVita centers were operational.
